

General Notice No. 1856 of 2021

THE CENTRAL ELECTRICITY BOARD

In the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 20 of the Central Electricity Board Act, the Central Electricity Board hereby fixes, as specified hereunder, the prices to be charged for the supply of electricity to domestic consumers under the time-of-use electricity Tariff 150C.

1. The prices that shall be charged by the Board during any particular month shall be in accordance with the tariff set out in the Appendix.
2. The time-of-use electricity Tariff 150C is applicable to domestic consumers who have installed electric chargers solely for the purpose of charging electric cars.
3. The Tariff 150C will be allocated to the electricity contract account dedicated for the electrical charging of the electric car. The consumer shall provide proof of ownership of the electric car when applying for the dedicated electricity contract account (supply).
4. Every bill shall be rounded to the nearest rupee.
5. The tariff set out in the Appendix shall be deemed to be applicable as from 1 November 2021.
6. For the purpose of accounting, electricity bills issued in respect of the consumption related to meter readings taken during the period starting on 1 November 2021 shall be calculated on a pro rata basis. For the purpose of this calculation, each day's consumption shall be deemed to be the equivalent of 1 /30 of the total consumption registered on the meter since the date of the last reading.
